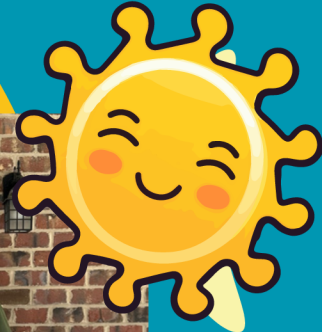




# Soul to Soul Outreach
